Ga-Ga Ball

Equipment:

- Tables to set up on their side
- 1 softball squishy ball which will bounce
- 1 cone

Scoring Key

Sportsmanship/following directions points:

Based on teacher and volunteer opinion.

Points can range from 0 to 5 being the most points awarded

Station Directions:

- Divide the class into one group of boys and one group of girls
- Select either the boys or girls to play first (I have found it is better to separate them because of quickness of this game)
- If girls play first, have them line up in front of the pit and allow the first 6 to get in
 - The boys will be off to the side watching
 - Allow girls to play for 3 minutes then switch to let boys play
- The object of the game is to eliminate other players by hitting them with the ball below waist
- The ball should remain on the ground and can only be hit with an open hand (slapping)
- If a player is hit below the waist they are out and leave the pit, as they leave a new player will come in, this is a continuous game! 6 people should always be playing
- If a student hits the ball out of the Ga-Ga pit, they are out.
- If the ball bounces off the table and then hits a student below the waist they are still out

Volunteer/parent important note:

I suggest having the homeroom teacher or volunteer be the referee and call people out when they get hit. This will eliminate any arguing from happening! Arguing or poor sportsmanship will result in not being able to play!
